

PROJECT BACKGROUND

The Sacramento Regional Transit District (RT) initiated the South Sacramento Corridor Phase 2 Study after identifying Light Rail Transit (LRT) as the Locally Preferred Alternative (LPA) to accommodate transportation needs in southern Sacramento. South Line Phase 1, between downtown Sacramento south of Broadway to Meadowview Road, opened in September 2003 and is now carrying significantly more riders than originally projected. RT is currently looking at expanding the South Line light rail system approximately four miles from the Phase 1 terminus at Meadowview Road to Cosumnes River College. Light rail will help serve the region's growing population by providing reliable service, reducing increases in automobile congestion, and decreasing air polluting emissions.

RT is nearing completion of preliminary engineering and evaluation of the impacts associated with constructing and operating the proposed light rail extension. To ensure that the issues most important to Sacramento residents, public agencies, and other affected parties were considered in the technical and environmental studies, RT hosted a series of meetings and information sessions from 2002 through 2005 to collect public input.

UPCOMING PROJECT MILESTONES

The Supplemental Draft Environmental Impact Statement/Subsequent Draft Environmental Impact Report (SDEIS/SDEIR) on the proposed project is expected to be released for a 45-day public review period in January 2007 and will detail project alternatives, environmental impacts, and mitigation measures. When the draft environmental document is released, a public review period will begin, during which a public hearing will be conducted to receive comments on the environmental review.

PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING PLANNED

In anticipation of release and public review of the Draft Environmental Document for the South Line Phase 2 Project, the Sacramento Regional Transit District (RT) invites you to attend an informational public meeting on Wednesday, January 3, 2007.

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss:

- new Cosumnes River College Station Design (including parking structure options)
- removal of Ruiz Court pedestrian access bridge option
- utility relocation to Detroit Boulevard
- how to read an Environmental Impact Statement/Environmental Impact Report
- related projects

Project exhibits will be on display in the foyer adjacent to the Orchard Room. Dr. Beverly A. Scott, RT General Manager/CEO and elected officials will provide brief welcoming remarks at 5:30 PM followed by a short presentation on the proposed project. Technical staff will be on hand to discuss the project and respond to questions and comments.

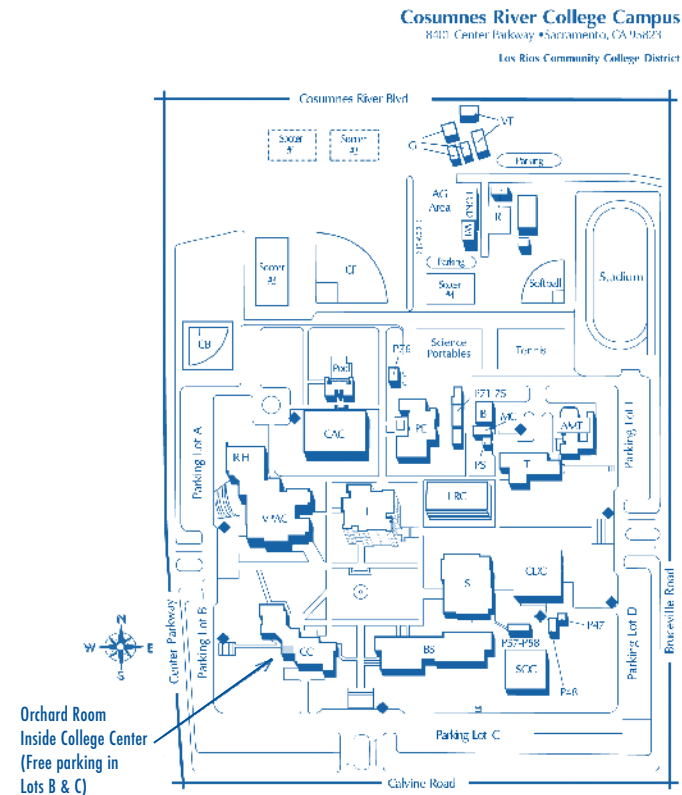
